



Alexander II Magnet School Face-to-Face Reopening Plan 2020-2021

The following plan is intended to provide an overview of the anticipated guidance for re-entry to the school building in a face-to-face setting. Our goal is to keep the safety of our students and staff at the forefront as we make decisions that we believe are in the best interest of our students, staff, and stakeholders.

School Day Times	School Doors Open – 7:50 AM Students Should Arrive by 8:20 AM Dismissal- 3:20 PM
Prior to Departure from Home	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If a student has a fever, the student should not report to school. • If a student exhibited symptoms of illness within the 24 hours prior to the student leaving for school, the student should remain at home.
Arrival and Breakfast	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School doors open at 7:50 am. • Students must be wearing a mask as they exit their cars. • Students must remain in cars prior to doors opening. • Students should exit cars and wait on the star until directed to enter the building. • Students must enter through the kiosk at the point of entry. • Students will go straight to their classroom after their temperature is checked. • Adults will be on duty in the car rider line and stationed throughout the building to monitor morning movement. • Students will have breakfast in their classrooms. • Access to the building will be restricted to staff and students.
Technology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Every student will need to bring their school issued device and charger on the first day they return to school.
Hallways and Transitions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hallway traffic will be monitored for social distancing. (6 feet apart) • Students should follow hallway traffic flow patterns that have been outlined. • Students should use the wooden stairs to go up to the second floor and concrete stairs to come down from the second floor.
Classrooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will be socially distanced and overall capacity has been reduced. • Distancing between individual student workspaces has been created. • Students will have individual boxes of instructional resources.

Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our school will provide students with grab-and-go meals for breakfast each day. • Lunch will be served at select pick-up points so that physical distancing can be maintained during lunch time. • Students will also be permitted to bring their own lunch, if preferred. • Lunch will be in classrooms to minimize interaction between groups of students. • Face-to-Face students will have the opportunity to pick up a box/bagged meal as they exit the building on Tuesdays. This will be breakfast and lunch for Wednesday.
Health and Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physical distancing guidelines and mandatory use of face coverings will be enforced for all individuals while in the building. • Should a student present with symptoms of COVID-19, (including fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea), our school is prepared to separate the ill student from the rest of the school until the student can be picked up. We have designated Dawn Ralston, School Nurse as our school's point person who will be responsible for the assessment of ill students. • To protect students and staff members from potential exposure to COVID-19, our school has designated space to be used as an Isolation Room. An Isolation Room is a place where a student with suspected COVID-19 symptoms, as determined by the school nurse, can be safely isolated in the building until they can be picked up by a parent/guardian.
Facility Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Routine cleaning is an important part of standard infection control practices for preventing the spread of COVID-19. • Appropriate signage (e.g., six-foot space markings and directional signs) has been added throughout the building to promote social distancing. • Water bottle filling stations have been installed throughout the building.
Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will not dismiss from the office. • Bridge walkers will be monitored and socially distanced as they are dismissed. • In an effort to maintain social distancing, the walkup area is temporarily unavailable. • Students will be dismissed from the classroom individually as parents arrive. Please display your carpool number so that you will be able to pick up your child. Carpool numbers will be issued to parents/guardians on the first day your child returns to school for face-to-face instruction.
Visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Access to the building is restricted to staff and students. • Meetings with staff should be scheduled and conducted virtually. • Walking students to class is not permitted.
Large Group Gatherings at School	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Large group meetings will be conducted virtually.

Instructional Week	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Face-to-face instruction will be four days a week: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Wednesdays will continue to be a virtual learning day; students will continue to learn from home on this day. This will allow teachers time to prepare lessons for virtual students and time for staff to clean the buildings midweek.
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
